

# Present progressive

The present progressive is used to talk about an action that is happening now or an action that will happen soon.



## Example

<b>AFFIRMATIVE</b>	subject + verb <b>to be</b> + infinitive + <b>ing</b>	He is screaming.
<b>NEGATIVE</b>	subject + verb <b>to be</b> + not + infinitive + <b>ing</b>	He is not screaming.
<b>QUESTION</b>	verb <b>to be</b> + subject + infinitive + <b>ing</b>	Is he screaming?
