AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES

1) Use 5.+A.+V.+O. I will go to summer camp soon.

I'll go to summer camp soon.

2) Use 5. + am/is/are + going to + V. I am going to move next July.

I'm going to move next July.

NEGATIVE SENTENCES

3) <u>Use S. + A + not + V.</u>

He will not be in this school next year.

He won't be in this school next year.

4) Use subject + "to be" + not going to + verb

We are not going to go to the movies tomorrow.

We aren't going to go to the movies tomorrow.

INTERROGATIVE SENTENCES

5) Use A. + S. + V.

Will you write to me?

Will you respond to my letter?

6) <u>Use "Am/Is.Are" + S. + going to + V.</u>

Are they going to play hockey tonight?

Tomorrow I will not talk on the phone.


