DID YOU KNOW..?

With the auxiliary will

*I will not wash the car next weekend.
You will not paint this wall.
We will not go skiing tomorrow.*



*I won't wash the car this weekend.
You won't paint this wall.
We won't go skiing tomorrow.*

With to be + going to + verb

*I am not going to listen to you!
He is not going to run the marathon.
They are not going to believe me!*



*I'm not going to listen to you!
or I'm not gonna listen to you! (when speaking)
He's not going to run the marathon.
or He's not gonna run the marathon. (when speaking)*
