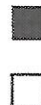


Future Tense

The future tense is used to talk about an action that is going to happen tomorrow, next week, in sixty years, etc. You also use it when you are guessing or making a promise.



| AFFIRMATIVE | NEGATIVE | QUESTION |
|--|--|---|
| Will + verb | Will+ not + verb | Start with will |
| She will give it to you tomorrow. | She will not give it to you tomorrow. | Will you give it to me tomorrow? |
