

FUTURE Tense

A Future means "later, tomorrow, next year, etc." Use the auxiliary "will" to write sentences in the future tense, then write the question, the WH question as well as the negative form.

Sentence	S.	A.	V.	O.
1. Ex.:	I	will	go	home next week.
2.	She	will	eat	cake tomorrow.
3.	I	will	watch	a movie on Friday.

Question	A.	S.	V.	O.?
1. Ex.:	Will	you	go	home next week?
2.	Will	she	eat	cake tomorrow?
3.	Will	you	watch	a movie on Friday?

WH. Q.	WH.	A.	S.	V.	O.?
1. Ex.:	Why	will	you	go	home?
Answer:	S. A. V. O. = I will go home because it is late.				
2.	Why	will	she	eat	cake tomorrow?
Answer:	She will eat cake because it's her birthday!				
3.	Why	will	you	watch	a movie on Friday?
Answer:	I will watch a movie on Friday because it's movie night.				

Negative form	S.	A. not	V.	O.
1. Ex.:	I	will not	go	home next week.
2.	She	will not	eat	cake tomorrow.
3.	I	will not	watch	a movie Friday.

B Write a question, a WH question, and a negative sentence using the sentence below.

Sentence: I will be in grade 6 next year.	
1. Question:	Will you be in grade six next year?
2. WH question:	What grade will you be in next year?
3. Negative sentence:	You will not be in grade six next year.
