HOW + ADJECTIVE

DID YOU KNOW?

- For a question about speed, use **how fast**:
Example: How fast can a Bugatti Veyron Super Sport go? 430 km/h
- For a question about height, use **how tall**:
Example: How tall is Mark? He is 1,90 metres tall.
- For a question about length or about time, use **how long**:
Example: How long can the anaconda be? More than 6 metres long
How long is your Mathematics class? It is one hour long.
- For a question about age, use **how old**:
Example: How old is your baby sister? She is three months old.
- For a question about a quantity that you can count, use **how many + the noun**:
Example: How many computers are there in the classroom? Three
- For a question about a quantity that you cannot count, use **how much + the noun**:
Example: How much salt do you need to put in the recipe? A teaspoon
How much money do you have in your purse? 15 dollars

1. Read the questions and write a short answer. If you don't know it, look it up on the Internet.

- a) How tall is the Empire State Building in New York?
The Empire State Building is 380m (roof height) and is a total of 443.2 m tall including the antenna.
- b) How long is the Confederation Bridge between New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island in Eastern Canada? It is 12.9 kilometres.
- c) How fast can a cheetah run?
They can run 93km/h in short bursts.
- d) How many players are on the court for a team during a basketball game?
There are five players on the playing court.
- e) How much sugar do you put in a birthday cake recipe?
You can put between 1-1.5 cups of sugar
- f) How old is your father? My father is 77 years old. (or less!).
- g) What is your favourite TV show? How long is it?
My favourite show is Greenhouse Academy, it is 25 minutes long.
- h) How much water can you put in one cup, in millilitres? You can put 250 ml in one cup.
