D A CAR ACCIDENT

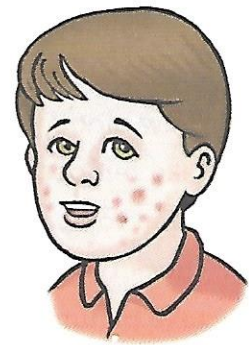
adhesive Aspirin CPR gauze rescue splint
