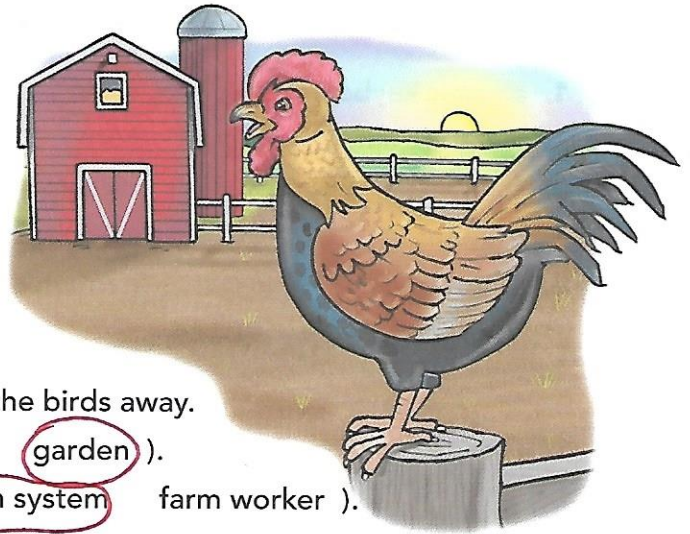


**A WHICH WORD?**

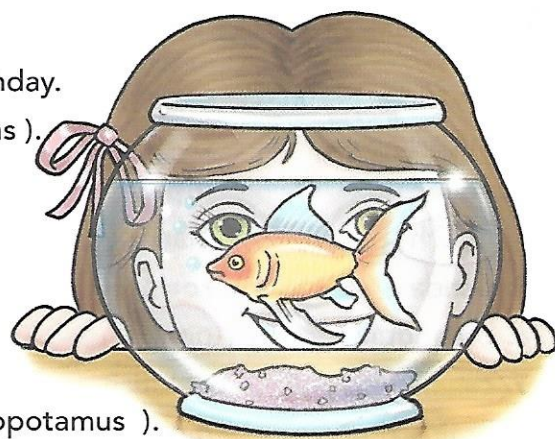

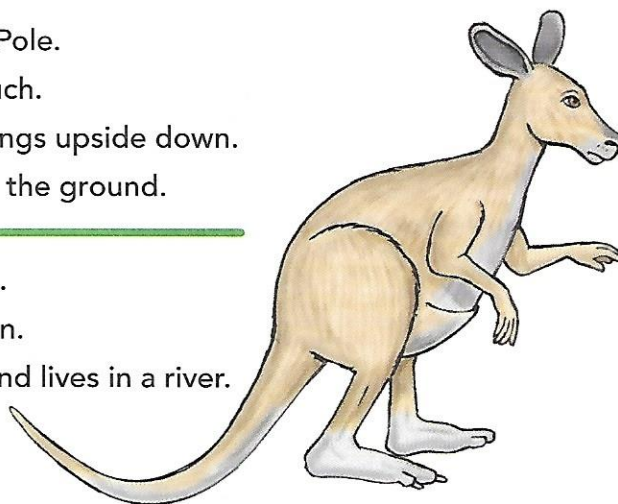

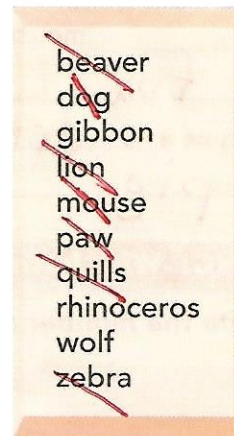
