











Demonstrative Adjectives & Pronouns

Demonstrative adjective describes a noun

Demonstrative Adjective + Noun

This chair is broken.

That car is cheap.

These clothes are wet.

Those birds are flying south.

Demonstrative pronoun identifies someone or something

Demonstrative Pronoun + Verb

This is my chair.

That is Richard's house.

These are her pens.

Those are migrating birds.



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
